FEAST DAY 2026: WELCOME!

The very first Feast Day was held nearly 800 years ago in 1229 when King Henry 3rd granted the Lord of the Manor the right to hold an annual fair on the Feast of St Peter.

Since 2009, when Feast Day moved back to Goldhill Common, it's grown into a local phenomenon with over 6,000 people regularly attending the Feast Day activities throughout the day.

The event couldn't happen without everyone coming to enjoy the day and throw themselves

into the activities around the Common. And the Feast Day committee who organise the whole event couldn't manage on the day without the scores of other volunteers who help on the day and beforehand.

This is a free event which is open to everyone and we send a huge thank you to our sponsors, stallholders, and advertisers, whose generous financial support helps to make this event possible. Of course, we can't forget the donations from all you lovely people too.

We appreciate that this is still a difficult time financially for many people. However, if you are also able to donate to Feast Day, this makes a huge difference to us being able to continue to provide this event, including the free concert in the evening. Our volunteers will be carrying official collection buckets and card readers for those who don't carry cash and you can also donate at the main Information Desk at any time.

As a non-profit-making enterprise any surplus funds go towards helping local



good causes and you can see how your donations helped local community organisations last year later in the programme.

In addition, in the run up to Feast Day there will be a range of community arts and cultural events throughout June. This starts with Bucks Arts week from the 6th - 21st June, and, back by popular demand, Chalfont St Peter Fringe will be hosting a range of local community arts and cultural events.

PLEASE BE A WOMBLE!

We would appreciate you taking any rubbish and litter home with you, or recycling it in the appropriate bins on site. If bins are full, please take your rubbish home to recycle! Remember, it's lighter when you're going home than when you brought it to the site!



WE'RE MAKING FEAST DAY GREENER - CAN YOU HELP US?

Our volunteers do a fantastic job picking up litter and making sure the Common is pristine the next day. However, you can really help by using the multiple recycling bins on site to dispose of your rubbish.

Please leave your car at home and walk to the Common, to reduce congestion and pollution, as well as the risk of a collision with pedestrians likely to be over-spilling into the roads. **On-site car parking is reserved for those who are blue disabled badge holders only.** You can park in the Church Lane car park, which will be free for the day, and take our complimentary shuttle bus to the Common or enjoy the short walk.

We'll have water available on-site at the information tent for people and animals which is especially important on a hot day so please bring your water bottles with you and refill for free!

Most stalls rely more on stall-holder energy than electricity and we've encouraged all of them to think about how they can help minimise their carbon footprint on the day.

Generators are reserved for essentials like the stage, tea tent and some fairground rides and there will be a short parade of classic cars. The toilet facilities comply with environmentally friendly standards. All our rubbish goes to FJL's recycling plant.

If you have any ideas for how we might improve sustainability further, do let us know.

So please help us keep our lovely village green by:

- ▶ Putting your rubbish in the recycling bins or taking it home.
- ▶ Walking to the Common and leaving your car at home.

LOOKING AFTER your VILLAGE: Chalfont St Pickers!



The volunteer group, Chalfont St Pickers, is making a huge difference to the well-being of Chalfont residents. Set up in answer to an increase in littering around the village, the volunteer group has grown in number from the founding members Ophelia, Debbie, Jeanette, Julia and Marie to over 35 active members.

Since setting up Chalfont St Pickers in the spring of 2025 the group has collected 100s of refuse bags of litter from Chalfont St

Peter's roads and public spaces - some dropped accidentally but, sadly, most deliberately dumped. It's a problem blighting our beautiful village that damages both the appearance of Chalfont St Peter and, arguably more importantly, the environment. Dropping litter also has a massive financial cost causing the Buckinghamshire County Council to spend £3.5m each year clearing it away!

Volunteering to litter pick is a way of alleviating the issue whilst doing something worthwhile for the community. It's also a fabulous way of connecting with like-minded people and making new friends - whatever your age!

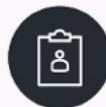
